



 Students connect with Caywood Families through Class Dojo by asking them to complete the Family Energy At Home Survey.


Evaluation:

Data was collected from the responses the Team received.


Do you have recycling at home?

How often do you unplug appliances in your home when not in use? $^{\rm 28\,responses}$




Have you installed LED light bulbs in your home?



Energy Content and Resources:


 Kenton County Energy Wise Google form for shutdowns during breaks.


