
Green Team Energy Podcast Series






All media content was original. Students wrote and produced their own podcast series.




The team used Zoom to communicate with each other and their teachers.. They also communicated on the phone. They used Youtube.com to share their podcast with others.




Our team used digital communication tools to make others aware of and include others in their project. We met to create our second podcast on zoom. When we recorded our podcast, some of use were in person using microphones and some were at home on zoom. Together, we were able to create a podcast to communicate our ideas about energy and the three R's.



Students utilized various technologies to design and create original work: Zoom, telephone, microphones, recording device, Youtube.com. Many attempts or prototypes were made until we were happy with our podcast.



Students identify and organize data/sequences to help understand and address/solve their project problems by listening to each of their podcast attempts and deciding if they needed to try again.



The team built knowledge to help develop and implement their project by attending sessions with teachers to learn about energy and sustainability. They gathered information about saving energy and then put it into a podcast to share.



Students participate in making decisions about the project by choosing how they would share their learning of saving energy. They made decisions on topics and on what they would say during the podcast. They each showed a passion and ownership for the project because they wanted to make it perfect and helpful to others.

Students used digital tools to help others feel safe in trying new things. The team used zoom and when that didn't work, called a student that was virtual to include her. They also offer advice to others in order to share their learning.

Project Impact

The purpose of the energy series podcasts is to share energy saving knowledge and advice with peers and teachers. The group hoped to impact others in their school and community to save energy. They also want others to reduce, reuse, and recycle when possible. Impact was measured by how many YouTube views we had because it told us how many people were reached. Our first podcast got 104 views and 7 likes. We hope to have even more with our second podcast!

Energy Podcast #1


