J.T. and Evan both worked with Mrs. Thibodeaux by bringing presentations and activities to the students in K-8th grade every other month, sharing their energy and excitement about recycling. Evan and J.T. also worked with teams of students who were assigned to different pick up locations throughout the school, depositing the material every Monday into the recycle center. On Tuesdays, the city picks up our recycling, so the two boys and their team would weigh all bags and record data onto the Pepsico website, which enters the school into different challenges to earn money and prizes.

Taking it further into the community, we worked with SWLA Autism Society to collect Mardi Gras beads and wrap them for their drive, which sells the beads to benefit a free summer camp for students with Autism. We also collected small hotel soaps to upcycle for the Seafarer's organization, which sends a gift to every seafarer that enters the Port of Lake Charles during the Christmas holidays. We also participated in Ecycle day (which our sponsor, Mrs. Judy Reeves worked) by bringing all saved technology that had been discarded at our school. Last but not least, students participated in an awareness video contest with the Environmental Group Calcasieu Parish and did a sweep winning all entries.






