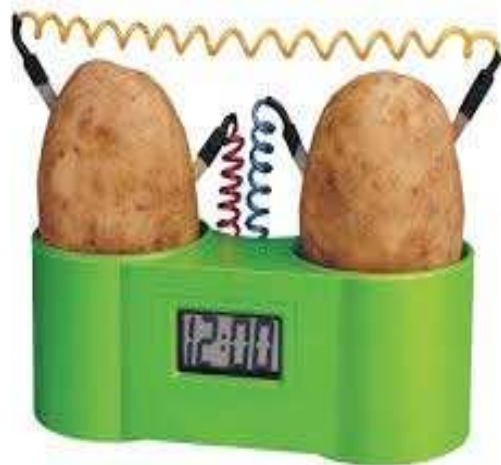

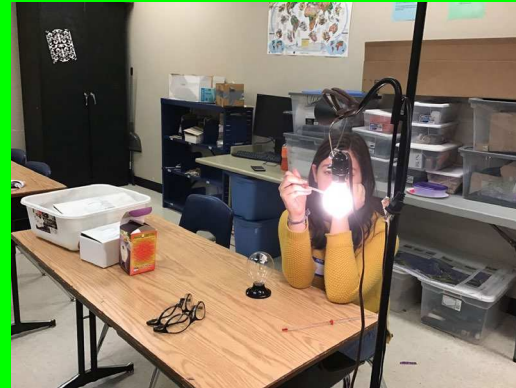

On Stem night families came into better understand what was going on in their children's classrooms. Our team had a few stations with energy related games to entertain and teach kids and their families on the different types of energy.



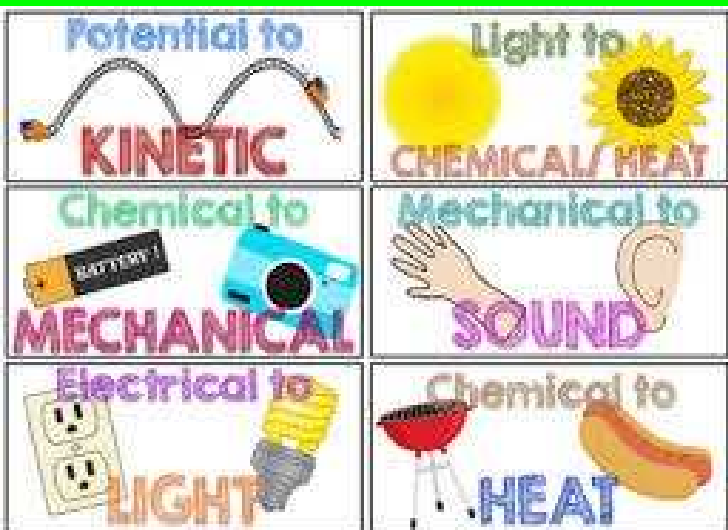
Storm Drains
